Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 5000 characters, including spaces)

I am an ICREA (Catalan Institution of Research and Advanced Studies) Research Professor based at the ICAC (Catalan Institute of Classical Archaeology), where I am in charge of the *Protohistoric Archaeology* research team. This team belongs to the consolidated group MIRMED-GIAC, recognised in the 2014 and 2017 calls of the Catalan Government (2014SGR1197 and 2017SGR970), and which I coordinate since 2022 (2021 SGR 00790). Since 2023 I am a member of the Institut d'Estudis Catalans (member of the International Academic Union).



Main contributions

Through the analysis of architecture and domestic space, I have contributed to the study of Iron Age social and household organisation in the Iberian Peninsula, southern France and North Africa. My doctoral thesis was the first synthesis on protohistoric domestic architecture in Catalonia, which has served as the basis for a number of works in Spain and France. In the last ten years, I have been PI of four projects within the *Plan Nacional* program of the Spanish Ministry of Science and Innovation, and three projects within the *Projectes Quadriennals d'Arqueologia* program of the Catalan Government (see C.3 of CVA). During this period, my research has been competitively funded with around 1 ME. At an international level, I have been responsible of one excavation zone at Althiburos (El Kef, Tunisia), in relation to which I led the *Urbanización y desarrollo urbano en los márgenes del territorio de Cartago. La ciudad númido-romana de Althiburos* Project (see C.3). Also, I have been responsible of the studies of architecture and urban planning in Iron Age archaeological sites of southern France such as Lattara (Lattes) and Pech Maho (Sigean). I have been visiting researcher at the Universities of Chicago and Montpellier. In the last ten years I have published 35 articles (25 as unique or first author), 40 books or book chapters (25 as unique or first author) and made 40 contributions to congresses. I have co-organized 6 international meetings or sessions. One of my concerns has always been to produce a significant number of open access publications.

The results of my research have been broadly disseminated to a general audience by different means: giving talks to the local people while conducting fieldwork and publishing dissemination articles or books. I would like to highlight two main projects: The DIGIBERS (*The socialization of research in the digital age: the case of the Iberian archaeology*) project (2017) and the TRANSCOMB *Estudio transdisciplinar y experimental de estructuras de combustión en el Mediterráneo occidental durante la protohistoria (1er milenio a.C.)* Project (2020-2023). The first one entirely focused on the dissemination of the Iberian culture through comprehensive materials based in audio-visual technologies. Experimental archaeology works within the framework of the second have been largely disseminated through the social media as well as organizing open-doors activities on-site, in events such as the *Week of Science* or the *European Heritage Week*. Also, in 2020-2021 I have been scientific advisor of the exhibition *The Iberian enigma*, organized by the Archaeology Museum of Barcelona, where I participated in the related dissemination activities with an article, an audio-visual, a lecture and a podcast. In 2024, I have co-authored the dissemination book *Catalunya en temps dels ibers*.

Since 2019 I am the Academic Supervisor of the Advanced Training Area (Classical Archaeology Master) at the ICAC, and I am a member of the Academic Committee of the Doctorate in Classical Archaeology. I have directed or codirected 7 PhDs (one of them an international co-direction with the University of Montpellier), as well as 29 Master's theses. In the last ten years I have obtained 4 PhD (2 FI -Catalan Government-, and 2 FPU -Spanish Ministry of Education-), one FPI (Spanish Ministry of Science), 5 postdoctoral fellowships (4 within the Juan de la Cierva call -Spanish Ministry of Science- and 2 within the Beatriu de Pinós call -Catalan government-) and one technician (PTA call -Spanish Ministry of Science-). Some of my former students have been granted with postdoctoral fellowships abroad, and others have become heritage management technicians in Museums or related institutions, and collaborate in some of the projects I lead. I have also served as an evaluator to different funding agencies in Spain (State Research Agency and AGAUR), France (Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation and CNRS), and the USA (National Geographic Society). I have been a reviewer for both national (*Complutum*, *Pyrenae*, *Revista d'Arqueologia de Ponent*, *Saguntum*, *Trabajos de Prehistoria* or *Lucentum*) and international journals (*Archaeological Dialogues*, *Archaeological and Anthropological Sciences*, *JAS Reports*, *Journal of Mediterranean Archaeology* or *African Archaeological Review*).
